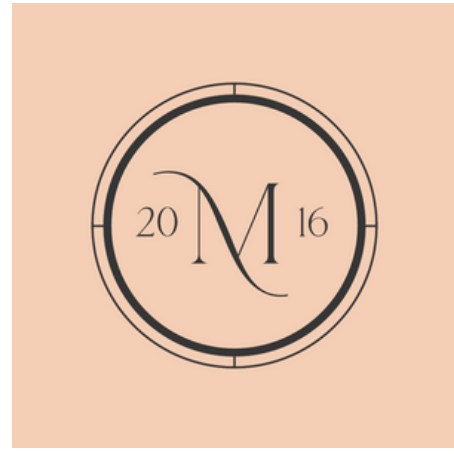
Franck Brichet
